Contractor Licensing Training Requirement-

All licensed general contractors (Class A, B, or C) within the City of Idaho Falls are required to complete .6 CEUs or one day of code related training each year in order to keep their licenses current. Subcontractors (Class D) are required to complete .3 CEUs of one half day of code related training. **Upon renewal of your license for the next year, the required CEUs must be completed for the previous year before your renewed license can be valid.** Those contractors who have acquired continuing education units from other programs are required to provide proof of the training received with their renewal applications. Training can consist of professional development and business related courses, but at least half (4 credit hours) should be building code related courses, including but not limited to I-code updates, Gypsum Association, American Plywood Association of America, American Concrete Institute, and Underwriters Laboratory training. The attendee of CEU classes is required to be the construction company's designated representative as prescribed by City Ordinance 4-7-13(A) in order for the license holder to receive credit for the training.
