Position: Building/Mechanical Inspector - Plans Examiner

The principal function of an employee in this class is to perform technical on-site inspections to ensure compliance with County ordinances and state and other applicable building codes. This is a journey level inspector/examiner position. The work is performed under the general supervision of the Building Official, with considerable latitude allowed for independent judgment and initiative. An incumbent in the position that has the certification and credentials to review building plans may be classified in pay grade 14. The principal duties of this class are performed in a general office and field environment and may include exposure to adverse weather conditions.

Requirements:

- High school diploma or GED equivalency is required. A technical degree in construction management or a related field is preferred.
- Two (2) years construction management or inspection experience is required; or
- Any equivalent combination of experience and training which provides the knowledge and abilities necessary to perform the work;
- International Code Council (ICC) Building Inspector certification is required;
- ICC Plan Review Certification (required for pay grade 14)
- ICC mechanical inspection certification is required within 6 months;
- An Idaho driver's license is required.
